In 2020, ICMPD established the Migrant Resource Centre (MRC) in Baghdad, together with the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs of Iraq (MoLSA). The main objective of the MRC is to raise awareness on the dangers and consequences of irregular migration, inform about existing legal pathways for Iraqi migrants, counsel returning migrants on reintegration measures available through MoLSA and other programmes, as well as provide guidance and counselling for incoming foreign labour migrants in Iraq. The MRC is a physical structure located at MoLSA's premises in Baghdad- Department of Labor and Vocational Training, offering a comprehensive set of services for intending, potential, and returning migrants, including one-on-one counselling and community education on migration.
